View Billing: View your invoices and statements directly from the app.

Parent Engagement & Messaging: Get more involved in your child's day. Teachers can now take fun pictures throughout the school day and send them directly to your phone where you can easily view and download them. Message teachers directly and see daily reports of your child's day.
